CONSENT DETERMINATION OF THE AUTHORITY

Employment relationship problem

[1] During the Authority's investigation meeting it was established that Wendy Clark was employed as a manager for Denese Foy (previously known as Denese Shaw) trading as Dublin Street Fish Supply from 1 August 2005 until 8 August 2005.

[2] The parties were able to settle their differences on the issues in the employment relationship problem and I agreed to make a consent determination order on the terms agreed. I was satisfied that the terms, as agreed by the parties, resolve the employment relationship problem.

[3] By consent I order Denese Foy (previously known as Denese Shaw) trading as Dublin Street Fish Supply to pay to Wendy Clark the sum of seven hundred dollars (\$700) compensation under section 123 (c) (i) of the Employment Relations Act.

[4] By consent, in addition, I order Denese Foy (previously known as Denese Shaw) trading as Dublin Street Fish Supply to pay Wendy Clark the filing fee of \$70.

[5] I record that the parties have agreed that the Authority's order and the terms as agreed represent a full and final settlement of all the claims and issues in the employment relationship

problem between both parties. Also, the parties have agreed on an arrangement for the full payment of both sums (in total \$770) with a date and time and place for the payment to be made unless it is made earlier by agreed arrangement.

[6] With those developments the investigation meeting was concluded.
