CONSENT DETERMINATION AS TO COSTS OF THE AUTHORITY

Employment Relationship Problem

- [1] Costs were reserved in the Authority's determination dated 24 August 2023 pending agreement between the parties or the filing of submissions.¹
- [2] The parties have now reached agreement about costs.
- [3] Counsel have advised in a signed joint memorandum dated 13 September 2023 that they seek from the Authority a cost order on the basis set out in the memorandum.

Orders as to costs

[4] Springs Junction Cafe and Motor Inn Limited (Springs Junction) and Jerry Hohneck are to pay to the Labour Inspector a total of \$2,321.56 comprised of:

- (a) \$2,250 as contribution towards its legal costs; and
- (b) \$71.56 being the filing fee.

[5] Springs Junction and Mr Hohneck agree to be jointly and severally liable for the costs.

[6] Costs and disbursements are to be paid within 28 days.
